#### 1. YOUTH WORKER

### **Key Duties**

The Youth Worker reports to the Chaplain, and is responsible for coordinating worship, discipleship and outreach activities by and among youth, including preparing recorded programs for publishing:

Specific duties include:

- 1. Organize, coordinate and prepare for youth worship services, fellowships and Bible Study for holistic discipleship
- 2. Preach and/or lead services and fellowships as organized
- 3. Production of weekly and special recorded youth programs for publishing online and on-air, and review of other Chapel recorded programs as assigned
- 4. Coordinate ministers and volunteers reaching the youth, and encourage and nurture ministry participants from among the youth church
- 5. Organize outreach visits to schools, homes, hospitals wherever permitted and assigned for spiritual guidance and compassion to the youth.
- 6. Organize seminars, conferences and camps for leadership development, spiritual growth and guidance, and constructive recreational activities
- 7. Provide pastoral care, counseling and career guidance to youth
- 8. Regular posts to and engagement of Chapel social media platforms (Facebook, twitter, Instagram, telegram, and others as they may emerge)
- 9. Liaise with other organizations that deal with youths, such as Kyambogo Students' Center.
- 10. Performs any other duties as may be assigned from time to time.
